

Job Opening: Pet Marketing Intern

The Oktibbeha County Humane Society (OCHS) is looking for a creative, self-driven Pet Marketing Intern to promote adoptable pets at the Starkville Animal Shelter. Reporting to the OCHS Director of Development and Community Relations, the individual will work approximately 15 hours a week with hours based upon his or her class schedule and the needs of OCHS. OCHS is glad to assist the successful candidate with obtaining college credit.

This is a grant-funded position with funding acquired for an eight-month period. Employment is not guaranteed, especially beyond expiration of the grant funding.

Job Responsibilities (including, but not limited to):

- Take photographs and video of adoptable pets.
- Write pet biographies soliciting information from personal knowledge and input from shelter staff and volunteers.
- Develop and oversee off-site adoption events and other opportunities to expose the public to adoptable pets.
- Promote adoptable pets by:
 - o Uploading relevant information to ShelterLuv (online animal welfare software)
 - o Posting to social media
 - o Preparing "Pet of the Week" e-mails and similar initiatives
 - o Facilitating off-site adoption events
- Assist with the development and implementation of specific promotions and initiatives designed to enhance and increase pet adoptions.
- Represent OCHS in a professional, compassionate manner

Qualifications:

Required

- Ability to clearly communicate and willingness to assimilate with the "voice" of OCHS.
- Experience taking and editing photos, preferably with a (provided) DSLR.
- Understanding of social media basics.
- Keen attention to detail with a positive attitude and compassion for others.
- Strong computer skills and an ability and eagerness to learn new technical skills (i.e. use of ShelterLuv, an online database where animal information is stored; new photography skills; etc).

- Ability to meet deadlines and work on own initiative.
- Possess a valid driver's license and have reliable transportation.
- Availability to work approximately 15 hours per week, including availability through August 2019.

Preferred

- Proven social media experience for an organization.
- Successful event-planning experience.

If offered the position, applicant must pass a criminal background check and drug testing.
